

Welcome to Erityisjäte's Kangasala site!

Upon arrival, please contact your host, who will provide you with further instructions.

Traffic and moving around the site

Parking and moving around the site is permitted in the designated area or in accordance with your host's instructions.

When moving around the area, keep to the route specified by your host and be especially cautious of work machinery with limited visibility. Standing and passing underneath loads carried by work machines is prohibited.

Personal protective equipment

When moving around the treatment area, wear high-visibility clothing with long sleeves and legs, safety footwear, and a hard hat. Also use other personal protective equipment as instructed by your host.



Photography and smoking

Photography is prohibited in production facilities and the field area. Taking photographs is only permitted if your host gives you permission to do so. Smoking is prohibited at the treatment centre.



Safety observations

Everyone moving around the area is requested to report any hazards and other safety observations to their host.

Assembly point

The emergency assembly point is the Kvartsitie junction in the field area and the shared assembly point for the entire site is in the car park in front of the office.

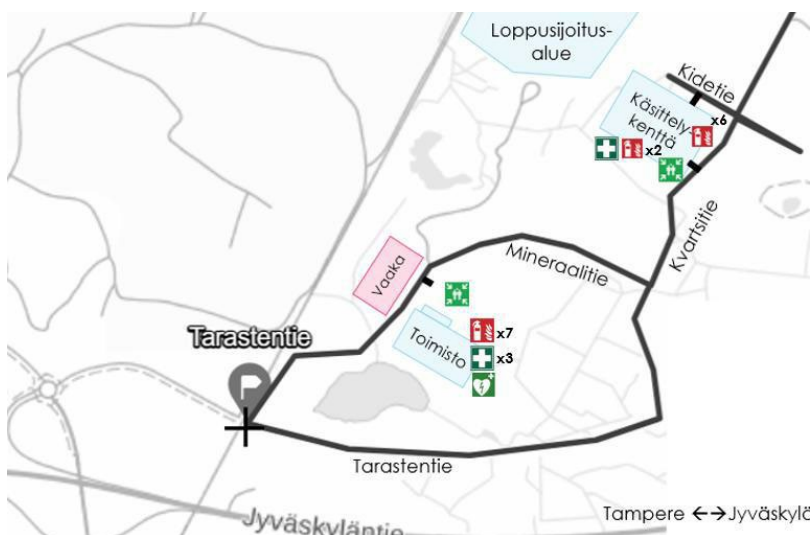

Reporting an emergency

In an emergency, call **112**

- ☐ **Explain what has happened and whether anyone is in danger.**
- ☐ Give the address:

- ☐ Answer any questions.
- ☐ Follow any instructions you are given.
- ☐ Do not end the call before you are given permission to do so.
- ☐ Keep the line free until help arrives. If anything changes, call 112 again.

What to do in the event of a fire

- ☐ **RESCUE** – Rescue anyone in danger. Warn others.
- ☐ **EXTINGUISH** – Use emergency fire extinguishing equipment if it is possible to do so without putting yourself in danger.
- ☐ **CALL 112** – Call the emergency services from a safe place.
- ☐ **LIMIT** – Prevent further damage by protecting/cooling any nearby structures, where possible. Limit the fire by closing doors behind you and turning off the ventilation system.
- ☐ **DIRECT** – Direct or arrange directions and unobstructed access to the scene of the fire for the rescue units.
- ☐ **NOTIFY** – Notify other workers and anyone else in the area.
