Upon arrival, please report to the info point in the office or contact your host, who will provide you with further instructions.

Traffic and moving around the site

Parking is permitted in the marked car park in front of the office, or wherever your host instructs you to park. Movement around the treatment plant is only permitted when accompanied by a host and while wearing the required protective equipment.

The speed limit in the area is 30km/h. Movement in the area is at your own risk.

When moving around the area, keep to the route specified by your host and be especially cautious of work machinery with limited visibility. Standing and passing underneath loads carried by work machines is prohibited.

Personal protective equipment

In addition to high-visibility clothing, safety footwear, and a hard hat, you must also use other personal protective equipment as instructed by your host.



Use of phones and cameras

The use of phones and cameras while moving in the production facilities and field area is permitted at the host's discretion. If you need to use your phone, you must stop in a safe place for the duration of the call.

Safety observations

Everyone moving around SEJ's area is requested to report any hazards and other safety observations to their host.



Assembly point

The emergency assembly point is in front of the office building.

Smoking

Smoking is prohibited at the treatment centre. Smoking is only permitted in the designated smoking area.

Reporting an emergency

In an emergency, call **112**

- ☐ Explain **WHAT HAS HAPPENED AND WHETHER ANYONE IS IN DANGER.**
- ☐ Give the address: **Ekokorventie 100, 29700 Pori**
- ☐ Prepare to answer any questions. You may also receive instructions.
- ☐ Do not end the call until **YOU ARE GIVEN PERMISSION TO DO SO.**
- ☐ Keep the line free until help arrives. **CALL 112 AGAIN** if anything changes.

What to do in the event of a fire

- ☐ **RESCUE** – Rescue anyone in danger. Warn others.
- ☐ **EXTINGUISH** – Use emergency fire extinguishing equipment if it is possible to do so without putting yourself in danger.
- ☐ **CALL 112** - Call the emergency services from a safe place or sound the alarm using the fire alarm button.
- ☐ **LIMIT** - Limit the fire by closing doors and windows behind you, and turn off the ventilation system.
- ☐ **DIRECT** - Direct the rescue department to the site.
